To reach the premises take AVT Bus line (C) Bizzozzero line, from the TRENITALIA Railways Square bus stop. The building is served with:

- 156 seats used for public parking, including 3 for disabled
- 70 private parking slots, including 2 for disabled, to be used by the College's occupants only

In the college students find single rooms with private bathroom, and on each floor a shared kitchen every 4 rooms.

- What is included: sheets, blankets, pillow and bath towels
- What is not included: kitchen equipment



There are also:

- 36-seat classroom and lecture hall equipped for 120 guests;
- Internet room cafeteria, gym with changing rooms, games room, music room, TV room;
- 4 study rooms, 2 meeting rooms and the library.
