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1. General information and organization

The Course belongs to the class L-20r - Communication Sciences (DM 16 March 2007, reformed pursuant to DM 1648/23) - is it activated according to the didactic regulations of 20/02/2019 or 22/11/2024?

The Course is delivered in Italian and in conventional mode (in presence) on the Varese campus, mainly in the Halls of the Bizzozzero University Campus in via Ottorino Rossi 9. There is also the possibility of videoconferencing with the Como campus, subject to availability of classrooms.

From the Academic Year 2025-2026, seminar and workshop activities will be carried out mainly at a distance in synchronous mode via the M. Teams platform. The above-mentioned activities form an integral part of the Educational Offer, as outlined below.

The main objective of the Three-Year Degree Course in Communication Sciences, which has been in operation at the University of Insubria since 2001, is to train communication professionals capable of carrying out intellectual and creative work that meets the needs of the economic and cultural development of our country, which is increasingly focused on the tertiary sector.

The strongly multidisciplinary course is structured in a wide range of subjects in the fields of linguistics, literature, law, economics, history, philosophy and communication. Compared to similar courses in Lombardy, the degree programme is characterised by the combination of a solid cultural background and a strong focus on professional skills.

The latter can be acquired thanks to an important offer of professional workshops and seminars, held by experts from the world of work, communication and journalism; in this sense, particularly noteworthy is the recent establishment of a Research Centre dedicated to creativity applied to the performing arts sphere and aimed at consolidating the students' knowledge and skills in a particularly relevant field.

The preparation acquired during the three-year course enables students to work in all areas of communication: from marketing to audio-visual languages, from public and institutional communication to mass communication, from communication of environmental emergencies to multimedia communication, up to new media, the web and the new professions linked to the world of journalism.

The three-year academic course is also the fundamental basis for access to the master's degree, which prepares professionals in which communication plays a decisive role in operational practices.

The teaching structure responsible for the course is the Department of Human Sciences and Innovation for the Territory (DiSUIT).

2. Admission to the study program

Access to the Course: open access

To gain access to the degree course, it is necessary, in accordance with current regulations, to hold a high school diploma or other qualification obtained abroad that is recognized as suitable. Good knowledge of general culture and in the area of Humanities and Communication Sciences are also required for access to the degree program. Enrollment in the degree program is free and requires, obligatorily, the taking of an entrance test, non-selective, to verify the student's initial preparation.

Mode of verification of initial preparation

Upon entering the Bachelor's degree program, the student must take a test, non-selective, to verify initial knowledge.

The test consists of the production of a short text of up to 20 lines on a topic determined by the Assessment Committee, within the time of 20 minutes. The production of the text is evaluated in terms of correctness, coherence and conciseness.

Students who do not achieve a minimum grade of 18/30 on the short production are given an additional educational obligation (OFA) that must be fulfilled within the first year of the course. For the fulfillment of the OFA, the student must:

1. participate in a collective remedial workshop run by a lecturer from the language-literature area, during which the problems and deficiencies revealed by the non-sufficient productions are addressed.
2. prepare on teaching materials made available on the e-learning platform, structured to provide a practical guide to written Italian. Students who have doubts or questions can refer to the same lecturer of the linguistic-literary area or to one of the tutors of the degree program.
3. take a short written exam in front of a committee to verify that the educational deficiencies have been made up.

The educational obligation is considered fulfilled when the student demonstrates that he/she has made up the deficiencies previously manifested. Students who do not take the knowledge test on any of the proposed dates will not be allowed to take exams until the end of the first year of the course.

Concurrently with the test focusing on text production, the CoS subjects students to 30 multiple-choice



questions on general culture and humanities topics to be completed in 40 minutes. They are awarded 1 point for each correct answer and 0 points for each incorrect or no answer. The outcomes of this part of the test do not have any impact on the assignment of OFAs, but are used by the CoS to collect informative data on the basic culture of the newly matriculated students.

As a means of preparation for the knowledge test, the student can make use of the entrance test preparation pre-courses organized by the University in late August-early September.

3. The educational path

There is no attendance requirement, with the exception of the Additional Educational Activities-UAFs (labs and seminars), which require attendance at least 75 percent of classroom or distance learning activities.

For non-attenders or students unable to attend the seminars/labs provided by the UAFs, it is also possible to include in one's Career Plan 1 or 2 additional exams to cover the UAFs or participate in Higher Education Courses that provide for the recognition of CFUs for the UAFs.

As a reminder, from the Academic Year 2025-2026, seminar and workshop activities will be conducted mainly at a distance in synchronous mode via M. Teams platform. The above-mentioned activities are an integral part of the Educational Offerings, as highlighted below.

It is also envisaged the mode of distance attendance in synchronous mode via M. Teams link provided personally to the student in the following cases:

- students with disabilities, subject to certification by the relevant office;
- students enrolled under the PA 110 cum laude education project;
- students domiciled abroad awaiting the completion of matriculation in the University's courses.

CFU/hour correspondence for each type of activity (frontal teaching, tutorials, laboratories, internships and apprenticeships, seminars, etc.)

The University Educational Credit - CFU, is the measure of the volume of learning work, including individual study, required of a student in possession of adequate initial preparation for the acquisition of knowledge and skills in the educational activities provided by the didactic Regulations of the courses of study, as indicated in Article 5 of Ministerial Decree 270/04.

Any educational activity (teaching, laboratory, internship or thesis, etc...) of the courses of study corresponds to a certain whole number of educational credits (CFUs).

Each CFU corresponds to 25 hours of the Student's commitment, including the hours of formative activity in the presence of the Lecturer, and the hours of independent study and personal reworking, necessary to complete his or her training.

The CFUs corresponding to each formative activity are acquired by the student upon passing the examination or other form of profit verification established in the Didactic Regulations of the course of study.

Educational activities/CFUs:



- lectures: up to a maximum of 8 hours / CFU;
- seminars and workshops: up to a maximum of 8 hours / CFU;
- professionalizing internship: 25 hours / CFU;

Means of verification of educational activities

The methods of verification and evaluation are detailed in the syllabus of each teaching.

Recognition of Language and Computer Certifications:

Recognition of college credits (CFUs) is done ex officio for the following teachings:

- ENGLISH LANGUAGE I, by submitting to the Student Secretary's Office a certification proving the passing of a test of level \geq B2, 5 CFUs will be recognized (of the 7 CFUs provided by the teaching). Once the certification is approved, the student must take the oral part of the ENGLISH LANGUAGE I exam (2 CFU).
- Recognition of course credit cannot be requested for the teaching of PROPEDEUTIC ENGLISH LANGUAGE and ENGLISH LANGUAGE II.
- INTRODUCTION TO SPANISH LANGUAGE, by submitting a certification proving the passing of a test of level \geq A2, and for the teaching of SPANISH LANGUAGE, by submitting a certification proving the passing of a test of level \geq B1 to the Student Secretary's Office. Five CFUs (of the 7 CFUs provided for the teaching) will be recognized. Once the certification is approved, the student will have to take the oral part of the INTRODUCTION TO SPANISH LANGUAGE exam and the SPANISH LANGUAGE exam.
- ELEMENTS OF FRENCH LANGUAGE, presenting a certification proving the passing of a test at or above the A2 level will be recognized 5 CFUs of the total 7. Once the certification is approved, the student must take the oral portion of the exam, 2 CFUs.
- The certification must not have been earned for more than 5 calendar years with the exception of IGCSE, IELTS and TOEFL certifications, which, however, are only valid for 2 calendar years. Here is the full list of certifications recognized by the degree program.

Recognition of professional skills:

Pursuant to Article 5 paragraph 7 of DM 270/04, the Course Council may recognize:

- professional knowledge and skills certified in accordance with the relevant regulations in force;
- knowledge and skills acquired in post-secondary level educational activities to the realization and design of which the university has contributed.

The request for recognition will be evaluated by the Course of Study Council. Recognition may take place if the activity is consistent with the specific educational objectives of the course of study and the educational activities for which recognition is requested, also taking into account the content and duration in hours of the activity carried out.

The maximum number of credits that can be recognized is 12 CFU.

Possible propaedeutics and/or barriers: see syllabus.

- You will not be able to take the English Language II exam if you have not passed the English Language I exam.
- You will not be able to take the Spanish Language exam if you have not passed the Introduction to Spanish Language exam.



4. Graduation requirements

The final exam, written under the guidance of a lecturer supervisor (possibly assisted by one or more co-rapporteurs), consists of the writing of a paper (Thesis), which demonstrates the knowledge acquired and the ability to organically structure materials related to the disciplines of the Course of Study. It may take the form of:

- (a) a research project (exposition, in synthesis, in which previous positions and studies inherent to a cultural-historical problem are gathered);
- (b) a report of interdisciplinary activities carried out within related scientific disciplinary fields;
- (c) an in-depth study of seminar, laboratory or internship work carried out during the three-year period;
- (d) an editorial work project.

The paper may also be written in a foreign language agreed upon in advance. The teaching load of the final paper corresponds to 8 CFU. You will find all the information by clicking here.

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Mode of conduct and evaluation, committee

The paper, produced under the guidance of the lecturer/speaker (possibly assisted by one or more co-rapporteurs), is discussed during the final examination. The latter consists of a short public presentation, followed by a brief discussion, before a committee of faculty members of the Degree Course. The judgment on the discussion of the Dissertation may lead to an increase in grades, relative to the weighted average, corresponding to:

- up to 2 points above average for compilative theses (sufficient);
- up to 4 points for adequately structured and documented theses (good);
- up to 6 points for elaborate theses with good reconstruction skills, completeness of information and insights for critical analysis (very good).
- in addition, the Commission, unanimously, has the exceptional possibility of awarding up to 8 points for Theses that show particularly outstanding abilities in the stages of gathering documentation and bibliographical material and critical processing of information, as well as in the overall organization of the paper and written exposition (very good).

The Commission, in addition, will increase the final score by an additional 2 points if the undergraduate has 9 seminar points through attendance, during the three-year period, of conferences/conferences, in-depth seminars or equivalent activities subject to evaluation by the CdS (see Art. 3, last paragraph).

The distinction of praise, upon the proposal of the Committee Chair or the lecturer supervisor, will be awarded to students whose final score corresponds to 110/110 and who have achieved at least 5 praises in the profit examinations of the Degree Course.

Students who have not earned at least 5 praises but with an average of 106/110 or higher may be awarded the distinction of praise upon the proposal of the Commission Chair or the lecturer supervisor and with the unanimity of the Commission, even in the absence of the requirement of the minimum number of praises in the profit examinations. The proclamation usually takes place at the end of the



graduation session.
