The Centre for Research on Minorities (CERM) of the University of Insubria announces the **CERM 2026 Prize** for the best doctoral dissertation, discussed within the last year, on topics related to minority communities, including, but not limited to, protection and vitality and functions of minority idioms; processes of language identity formation and functioning in migratory contexts; language planning and minority language education issues; language repertoires of migrants in Italy; non-discrimination and protection of minority languages; linguistic, social and cultural inclusion of migrants; and training in minority languages.

The prize consists in the publication, within the Series "Quaderni del CERM" for the types of Ledizioni of Milan (<https://www.ledizioni.it/categoria-prodotto/sociology/quaderni-del-cerm/>), approximately within the year 2027, of a monographic volume originated from the doctoral thesis, after an evaluation of merit made by the Evaluation Committee.
